Finance Updates – Eric Baertsch (include surplus dollars update)

- Reports were sent out
- December turned out to be a good month Ended up \$585 surplus after moving \$21K to council reserve
 - Offering (special services) substantially up over last year (largely due to in person services and appeal)
- Projects in mind for council reserve
 - Replace Parking Lot lights with LEDs 2 estimates received
 - Speaker system for outdoor services
 - Updating phone system
- o 2022 budget will be presented on Sunday
 - Pre-meeting not a lot of questions came from that meeting
 - There is roughly \$70K not in dedicated funds that is in reserve and can be used to cover any shortfall as well as a credit line
 - Nadine to check on possibility of refinancing mortgage early
 - Change on the dedicated fund report the PPP loan did get moved to its own line item under church operations
- Concerns year over year, expenses have gone up and revenue has gone down. How do we continue to grow the congregation?

- Project: Converting parking lot lights to LED lights
 - o No feedback on the already converted lights from the neighbors
 - Concern about being obnoxious to the neighbors
 - We should be ok with the tree coverage on the south side
 - Could we talk to the electrician about options if this becomes an issue
 - We can hand out flyers to the neighbors to notify them as well
 - One proposal is half the amount of the other large company vs. small company
 - 1/3 of our lights are not working
