Finance Updates – Eric Baertsch

- o YTD profit of \$6.75
- Under budget on expenses
- ½ way through the year, we were expecting to be down \$27K, but we are essentially breaking even
- Cost of landscaping came in higher than expected
 - Inflation and cost of materials
 - Widening the space (offset by removal of the capstones)
 - See below for details
 - Small group met and wanted to make sure that increased cost falls in the amount that was approved
 - After looking at the details of the approval, it appears we don't need to go back for further approval
 - Would ask the congregation for help with the additional funds needed

Old Business -

- Twin Cities Bronze practice and storage space update (NaDyne)
 - Agreement is signed for one year; they will move in the first week of August; need to get their practice schedule and concert schedule (concerts @ MTC) on our calendar.
 - Moving in first week in August
 - o They will also do several concerts throughout the year, which will need to be scheduled
- Landscaping project update/fundraising (Pastor Tom/NaDyne) Contract Signed waiting for them to get us scheduled and want 50% down

- Total Cost \$91,672.09 (73,804.50 hardscape and \$17,867.59 for landscaping) includes extending width an additional 10'
- o Funds Raised/Dedicated \$50,663 + \$35,000 (asset renewal) = \$85,663
- Difference to Raise to go ahead with project 6009.09
- Ideal amount to raise to lessen the amount taken out of the asset renewal \$20,000
 - Patio will stamped concrete will ask the congregation to vote on symbols (will be put on the website
 - Symbol will be used for campaign as well renewal, rebirth, resurrection
 - August 14th Tom will talk about this and the goals and ask for gifts and hope that they come in by September 11th – rally Sunday
- Three council funded projects update (NaDyne)
 - Should update congregation at some point about the status of these projects

 - Instruments 95% piano, singing with choir leadership, brass, strings, acoustic guitar, organ
 - Shorter worship, creed, sing together, communion are of value

 - Are we going to be able to plan for Wednesday Night Suppers?
 - Previous illness seasons there were no restrictions
